

## The Pocket Theatre presents Don Quixotes by Greek Playwright/Actor Glyka Stoiou: A Cross-Cultural Collaboration



WHAT: The unbelievable adventures of Don Quixote as told by two scamps, who go on a trip to 16<sup>th</sup> century Spain and play almost all the roles in an interactive show that creates an explosion of images reminding us of a hero who gives courage to those who wish to change the world for the better. After visiting Greek schools and theatres, as well as presenting in Luxemburg and Alaska, *Don Quixotes* lands in Seattle

WHO: An experiment in long-distance collaboration utilizing contemporary communication technologies, *Don Quixotes* (adapted from the Cervantes by Glyka Stoiou) is being staged on the premise that a Greek actor (Stoiou) and an American actor (Carolynne Wilcox) can rehearse together with a director (Rebecca Goldberg), mostly via Skype, and deliver a bold, physical and interactive experience suitable for audiences of all ages.
